The Curriculum Committee met on a weekly basis throughout the 2009-2010 academic year. During the year, the Curriculum Committee reviewed a total of approximately 169 proposals*, which included 26 proposals for new courses; 43 proposal requests for revisions to academic majors and minors; 91 courses (including proposed changes in title, credits and prerequisites); and the review of approximately seven new or existing Scribner Seminars.

Significant among these proposals were proposed writing in the major requirements for 17 academic departm
major revisions of the Art History and Sociology majors; and the elimination of a significant number of int

issues during this academic year including:
