

- Cords must be properly approved (by Underwriters Lab)
- Approved cords must be for temporary use only (no more than 90 days)
- Extension cords may be used for remodeling and maintenance repair
- It is permissible to use extension cords to light holiday decorations
- Extension cords should be sufficient for the use and sized appropriately
- All extension cords must have a ground (round or u shape prong)
- While using extension ensure there are no trip hazards
- Must use a minimum of 16 gauge wire, but review your use as you may need a different gauge wire
- Multi Plug Surge protectors are authorized for use but must be plugged directly into an outlet
- GFI protected extension cords must be used in wet or damp locations
- Never remove plug from socket by pulling the cord
- Do not use extension cords that are frayed or cracked
- Do not daisy chain extension cords together
- Ensure you have no trip hazards
